ASDoc release on November, 2011

Major changes for this release of the *ActionScript® 3.0 Reference for the Adobe® Flash® Platform* include:

- Refresh right-pane only on selection, instead of entire page.
This feature improves page-load performance by implementing a right-pane only refresh on selection. This feature improves page-load times in the range of 25-50%.
- Improved linking to Adobe User Guides
Reorganized the **See Also** sections into three areas - **More Examples**, **Learn More**, and **Related API Elements**. This reorganization makes it easier to find examples and usage information for a class or class element.
For example, see the [ViewNavigator](#) class.
- The **Show Packages and Classes** option is now the default to address a frequent customer request.
- Fixes for issues associated with localization and translation.

ASDoc release on August 2011

Major changes for this release of the *ActionScript® 3.0 Reference for the Adobe® Flash® Platform* include:

- Support for a quick search added to the Packages and Classes lists.
The quick search lets you filter the content of the Packages and Classes lists as you type. This feature is not supported on IE 7 and IE 8.
- When displaying all classes in the Classes list, selecting a class name in the list continues to display all classes.
In the previous release, selecting a class name in the Classes list while displaying all classes changed the Classes list to display only the classes in the package of the selected class.
- Added a Home link to the top of all pages.
The Home link lets you navigate back to the index.html page from anywhere in the reference.
- Fixes for issues associated with localization and translation.

ASDoc release on May 2011

Major changes for this release of the *ActionScript® 3.0 Reference for the Adobe® Flash® Platform* include:

- Added a feedback link to the top of each page so users can rate the page. This feature is not available in all languages.
- Added links from the reference to the user guides.
- Fixes for issues in the appendix and index files.
- Fixes for issues associated with localization and translation.

Known issues

Listed below are known issues for the *ActionScript® 3.0 Reference for the Adobe® Flash® Platform*:

- For the best results, Adobe recommends that you use a recent browser release, such as Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 or 9, Mozilla Firefox 3, Google Chrome 6, Apple Safari 4, or later versions of these browsers.

- To view the downloadable version in Internet Explorer 8 or 9, you must make sure to set your security options correctly.

In Internet Explorer, set the security options by using the following procedure:

- 1 Use Tools > Internet Options to open the Internet Options dialog box.
- 2 Select the Security tab.
- 3 Select the Custom Level button.
- 4 Scroll to the “ActiveX controls and plug-ins” option.
- 5 Enable the “Initialize an script ActiveX controls not marked as safe for scripting” option.

Note: This setting causes Internet Explorer to issue a warning about your security level. Alternatively, you can view the downloadable version in FireFox so that you do not have to make this change to Internet Explorer.

- For the downloadable version, the packages and classes lists do not appear in Google Chrome. This is a known issue in Chrome: <http://code.google.com/p/chromium/issues/detail?id=40787>.

The packages and classes lists also do not appear in Internet Explorer 7.

Adobe recommends that you view the downloaded version in Internet Explorer 8 or later, or in Firefox.

- When using Google Chrome, selecting a link in the reference can open a new tab. This behavior is caused by the following issue in Chrome:

- The Delicious 1.0.4 plug-in for Chrome can cause links in the platform reference to function incorrectly.
- The APIs provided with Adobe Digital Enterprise Platform - Guides 10.0 support Adobe AIR 2.0 but are incorrectly tagged as supporting AIR 1.0. The APIs in the following packages support AIR 2.0.
